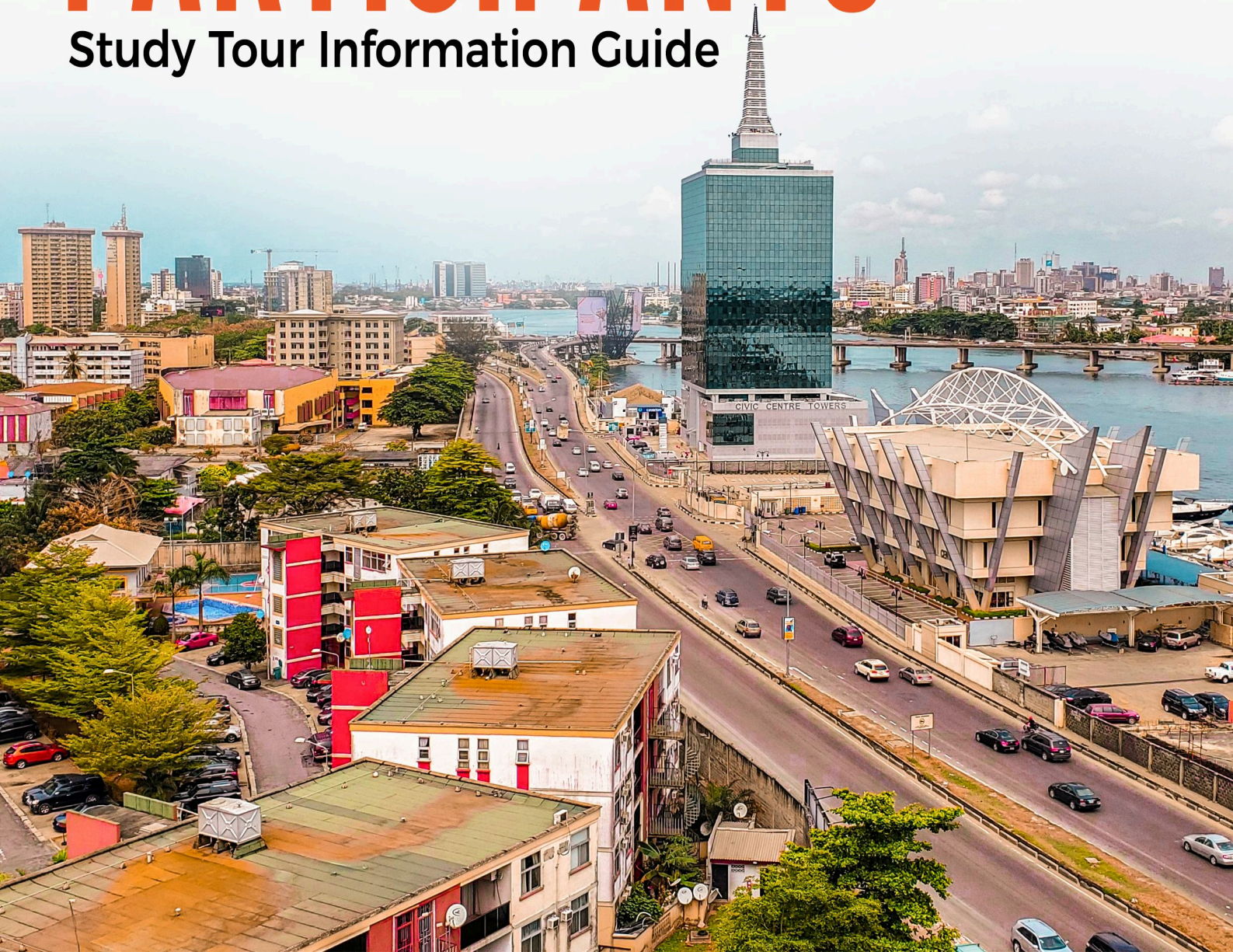

VISA REQUIREMENTS

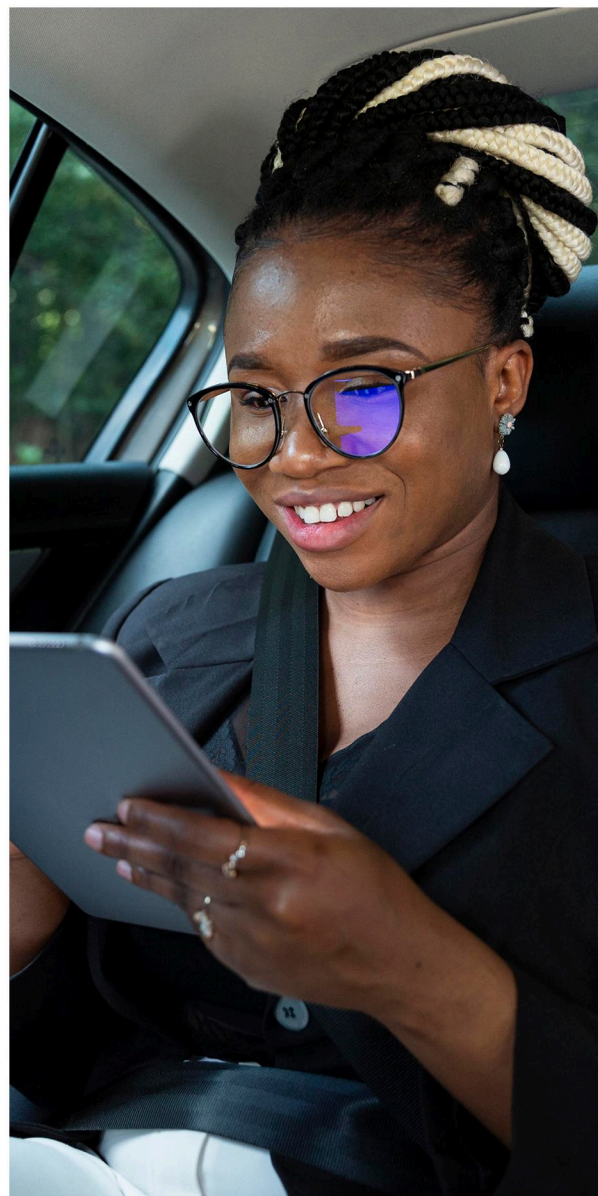
- ECOWAS citizens: Visa-free entry; bring a passport valid for six months.

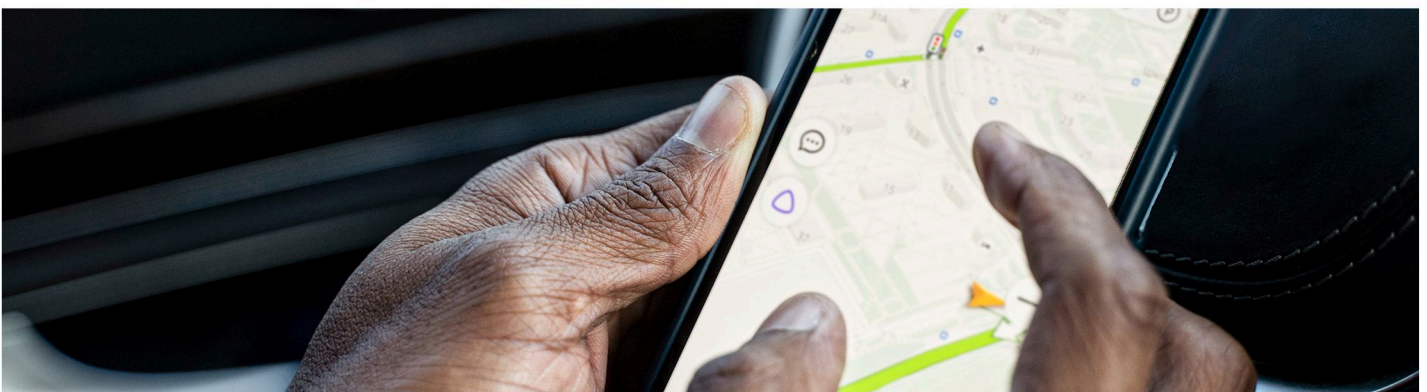


TRANSPORTATION TIPS

SAFETY TIPS

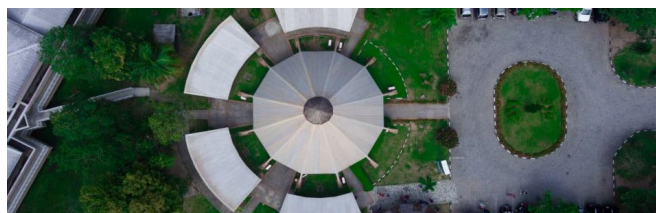
- Avoid carrying large sums of cash or valuables.

Discover Nigeria's rich history and cultural artifacts, including famous relics like Nok Terracotta sculptures.



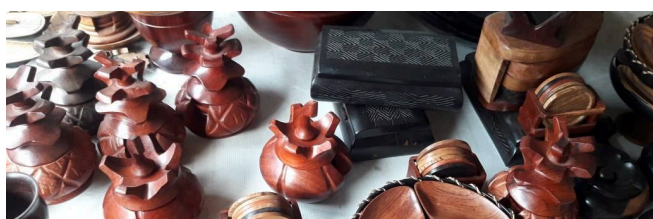
03 EXPERIENCE FREEDOM PARK LAGOS
