









# 1. Background

#### 1.1. **CAMESCO**

Cambodia's Entrepreneurial Ecosystem Strengthening Conference (CAMESCO) is an initiative established to build a network with like-minded stakeholders to strengthen Cambodia's entrepreneurship and investment ecosystem. This allows the showcase of the best practices in promoting collaboration and trust building and fostering entrepreneurship culture among Entrepreneur Support Organizations (ESOs) and system's actors.

CAMESCO is envisioned as a regular annual conference to bring together local and international stakeholders within the entrepreneurial development community and explore challenges and opportunities to build a strong and attractive Cambodia's Entrepreneurial and Investment ecosystem. The second edition of CAMESCO was held in 2023 joined by more than 180 participants both the local and regional stakeholders within the entrepreneurial development space. CAMESCO is being conducted under the Enhancing Entrepreneurial Ecosystem and Investment (3Ei) initiative, co-financed by Khmer Enterprise (KE), Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC), and Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) and co-implemented by Khmer Enterprise and Swisscontact.

#### 1.2. CAMESCO2024

CAMESCO2024 will be held on 25th November 2024. The theme for CAMESCO 2024 is "Power of Collaboration for Impact" The event will feature two focused tracks:

Impact Investing Track: Harnessing Collaborative Power to Build the Impact Economy

• **Entrepreneurial Ecosystem Track**: Harnessing Collaborative Power for Drive Systemic Transformation

The pre-launch event of the Cambodia National Advisory Board for Impact (Cambodia-NAB) under the Impact Investing Track that will unveil Cambodia-NAB's strategic initiatives and seek to forge a coalition with GSG National Partners in developing a vibrant impact investment ecosystem, aligning with the GSG Impact Partnership to catalyze investments and entrepreneurship for the benefit of people and the planet.

Fostering innovation and continuous improvement through a broader perspective under the **Entrepreneurial Ecosystem Track**, stakeholders will collaboratively work **towards** systemic changes that enhance Cambodia's entrepreneurial ecosystem.
